

APRSAF Poster Design Competition 2010



In November 2010, the Asia Pacific Regional Space Agency Forum will be held in Melbourne. This event promotes collaboration between the regions space agencies.

In celebration of APRSAF, and the International Year of Biodiversity, students between the age of 8 and 11 are invited to design a poster based on the theme:

“Space Technology to Help the Earth”

A Power Point presentation is available from www.vssec.vic.edu.au to assist teachers to introduce the topic and generate discussion.

Three posters will be selected to represent Australia in the final based on the following criteria:

- How well the poster addresses the theme
- Creativity
- Originality
- Technical skill relative to age

The winning posters will be displayed at APRSAF-17 in Melbourne, 23rd – 26th Nov 2010. All finalists will receive a certificate of participation and prizes will be awarded for the best three posters as judged by the APRSAF participants.

1. Posters should be A3 in size.
2. Pencil, crayon, water colour, oil painting and computer drawings are accepted.
3. Photos are not accepted.
4. The drawing must not include words or slogans and must not represent any particular individual, organization or brand name.
5. Posters should be the work of no more than two students
6. Posters should be labelled on the back with the following information
 - Students name
 - Students school
 - School address
 - Students age
